

Temporary COVID Policy Exception – Illness Related Excused Absences

Due to the current university and CDC recommendations related to COVID-19 we as a college are making a temporary modification to our assessment related absence policy. Individuals who are unable to attend class due to an illness will not be adversely impacted for missing an assessment or required course component or activity.

All absences must be proactively reported prior to assessments, required classes and scheduled course activities through the Absence Report Form - <https://pharmacy.wsu.edu/doctor-of-pharmacy/current-student-resources/block-testing/>.

Students who have an illness related excused absence will work directly with the course instructor(s) to determine a plan to address any missed course material, assessments, or course components.

Absences related to elective course work need to be communicated directly to the instructor for the course.

Any absences for non-illness related issues will follow our absence policy.
